ST. VALENTINE'S MASSACRE 100

Rules for the Event:

1. NO studded tires, chains or any traction enhancement devices. NO loading of tires. One tire per corner is allowed. No size constraints. All tires must be DOT approved. No Duallys.
2. NO 4 wheel drives and NO all wheel drives allowed. On 4 wheel drives, one drive shaft must be removed. On all wheel drives, either the front or rear drive shaft must be unhitched.
3. Mini vans, pick up trucks, hearses, and all types of cars are allowed. Diesel rigs are allowed. No plows allowed. No sanders allowed.
4. Minimum age to compete is 16 years old with parental consent release form completed.
5. Driver must have working seat belt. Five point harness suggested but not mandatory.
6. All glass except windshield must be removed.
7. All doors must be welded or chained shut.
8. All hoods must have a 12x12 hole cut in them.
9. All vehicles must have a working fire extinguisher.
10. Driver must have helmet, long sleeve shirt and long pants.
11. 4 point cage highly recommended but not mandatory. Cage can have a hoop from side to side and 1 leg forward on each side. Absolutely NO bars in front of the radiator. NO reinforcement of any fenders allowed. Full cages accepted.
12. Both front doors may have a piece of flat stock 3/16" thick by 6" wide welded to them, or 2" x 2" square tubing. They may not extend more than 4" ahead of the door or behind the door.
13. Battery must stay in stock location.
14. Windshield wipers are allowed.
15. NO alcohol allowed in the pit area or in race vehicles.
16. A racing style fuel cell is not mandatory but recommended. No cutting of the trunk floor or rear firewall to install fuel cell. Must have a sheet metal firewall separating trunk from the drivers compartment if a fuel cell is used.
17. Fuel cell must be mounted with a minimum of two 2" by 1/8" straps.
18. NO passengers.
19. All exhaust must exit underneath the vehicle.
20. All vehicles must have non-toxic antifreeze or water in the cooling system.

IMPORTANT

You must provide a scorer. That scorer must attend the scorer's meeting. All drivers must attend the driver's meeting. Score sheet must be turned in at the end of the event - no score sheet, no finishing position, no purse.

Red flags will be used in emergency situations. Situations to include but not limited to roll overs, drivers door to traffic, fire.

All drivers must complete registration form and pay a \$30 registration fee at the pit tower. Once registration is paid you will draw a chip for starting position.

In the event the track has no snow or ice, this event will become a 4 cylinder enduro only.

All vehicles and vehicle debris MUST leave the speedway the day of the event.
